



Biola University subscribes to the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) of the College Board. Credit for CLEP general examinations will be awarded only in those areas where a general education requirement has not been met with previous college course work and only up to the amount needed to complete the requirement. Credits will be awarded for CLEP subject examinations in areas not covered by CLEP general examinations provided no college credits have been attempted or earned in the same field. After 27 units of college coursework have been completed (including transfer units), students are no longer eligible to take CLEP exams (exception: foreign language and pre-calculus and calculus).

Biola requires that optional essay portions of some exams be taken to complete the requirement.

Credit by exam cannot be earned for a lower-level class if a higher-level class has been taken in that field. Students should NOT take English Composition through CLEP.

Biola accepts approved scaled score of **55 or higher (higher score required where designated)**. The list below shows which CLEP exams are accepted by Biola University.
